

Grinnell College in Iowa announced the winners of the 2011 Grinnell College Young Innovator for Social Justice Prize.

Eric Glustrom, executive director, and **Boris Bulayev**, president, of Educate!, a non-profit based out of Boulder, were honored for their demonstration of leadership, creativity and commitment in their field and their accomplishment in effecting positive social change.

Glustrom and Bulayev, both 26 years old, have founded and pioneered this organization that provides social entrepreneurship training, long-term mentorship and access to capital to help Ugandan youth create and lead solutions to the biggest issues facing their country.

The government of Uganda recently asked Educate! to incorporate its social entrepreneurship course into the national education system.

As winners of the prize, Bulayev and Glustrom will receive \$100,000 — \$50,000 to them and \$50,000 to an organization they designate.
