

Educate!'s Monitoring and Evaluation team, in partnership with Innovations for Poverty Action, conducted a randomized controlled trial of the Educate! Experience program in Uganda.

In 2014, after the full two-year program, we saw the following effects:

Control vs. Treatment



Educate! grads earned \$173 per year more

Control = \$165/yr. Educate! grad = \$338/yr.

## **SAVINGS BEHAVIOR**



Educate! graduates scored

**20.4% HIGHER** 

than the Control Group on a scale measuring their savings behavior



Educate! female graduates scored

**46.6% HIGHER** 

than the Female Control Group on a scale measuring their savings behavior
